



Dear Metro-North/Farm Fresh Poughkeepsie Customer,

Thanks for reserving this package. The Northeast's thriving sheep industry is showcased and celebrated each year at the famous New York State Sheep & Wool Festival in Rhinebeck, NY. **Next, you will need to purchase the rail package after July 1st or the day of your tour at any MNR ticket vending machine or full-service window.**

IMPORTANT: RAIL TICKETS ARE VALID FOR OFF-PEAK TRAVEL UP TO 60 DAYS INCLUDING DATE OF PURCHASE.

When you purchase this package you will receive two tickets: a round-trip rail ticket and a special event ticket marked "**FARM FRESH**".

NOTE: This DOES NOT include your festival tickets, which may be pre-purchased from EscapeMaker or at the gate entrance the day of the event.

To get to the Farm Fresh bus that will be your transportation throughout the day, take Metro-North's Hudson Line to Poughkeepsie Station. Give the conductor your rail ticket to punch and give back to you. **Make sure to hold onto your rail ticket for the return trip home.**

When you get to the station, follow the signs to the bus area and look for the loop bus stop. Your bus will be the one with the sign that reads "**DUTCHESS COUNTY FARM FRESH**". When you board the bus, simply give the driver your special event ticket marked "**FARM FRESH**".

10:44 a.m. The bus meets the train arriving Poughkeepsie Station

11:00 a.m. The bus departs for the festival

11:40 a.m. The bus arrives at the fairgrounds

4:50 p.m. PROMPTLY. The bus departs from the fairgrounds for Poughkeepsie Station to connect with the train departing at 5:50 p.m. or you may stay in Poughkeepsie longer to shop and have dinner.
